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Free Early Years Education and Childcare

All 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours of free early education. From September 2017 there will be an additional 15 hours of free childcare available for families that meet the Government's eligibility criteria.

Eligibility

The government has set the following eligibility criteria:

- Both parents are working - or the sole parent in a lone parent family.
- Each parent earns, on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at the national living wage and less than £100,000 per year.

How to Apply

Parents apply online via www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. Parents who need assistance or who do not have access to the internet can ring the childcare service Customer Centre on 0300 123 4097.

Eligible parents will be given a code which will be valid for 3 months, parents will be asked to re-confirm their eligibility towards the end of the 3 month period. Please give details of the code and National Insurance numbers to the school office.
